SENATE BILL NO. 2426

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF STATE GENERAL FUNDS TO THE
2 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE
3 EXPENSES TO OPERATE AND MAINTAIN THE WILDERNESS TRAINING PROGRAM,
4 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of
9 Human Services for the purpose of defraying the expenses to
10 maintain and operate the Wilderness Training Program for the
11 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending
12 June 30, 2000. \$1,500,000.00.

13 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Legislature that the
14 funds provided herein shall be utilized to the fullest extent
15 possible by the Department of Human Services to ensure not less
16 than one hundred (100) first-time youth offender placements are
17 served for not less than one hundred twenty (120) days during
18 Fiscal Year 2000.

19 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
20 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund not
21 otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
22 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
23 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or
24 officers, in the manner provided by law.

25 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
26 and after July 1, 1999.
