6	SECTION 1. Section 49-7-163, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
7	amended as follows:
8	49-7-163. It is unlawful for any person sixteen (16) years
9	of age or older to hunt or take any migratory waterfowl within
10	this state without first procuring a state migratory waterfowl
11	stamp and having the stamp in his possession while hunting or
12	taking any migratory waterfowl. Any penalty for not having the
13	stamp in possession while engaged in hunting or taking migratory
14	waterfowl shall be waived if the person can verify purchase of a
15	stamp prior to the date of the violation. Each stamp shall be
16	validated by the signature of the licensee written across the face
17	of the stamp. Any person exempt from having a hunting license
18	under Section 49-7-5 is exempt from procuring a state migratory
19	waterfowl stamp. The commission shall determine the form of the
20	stamp and shall furnish the stamps to bonded agents for issuance
21	or sale in the same manner as other types of licenses.
22	SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
23	and after July 1, 1999.
