5	SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
6	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
7	Treasury to the credit of the State Board of Funeral Services for
8	the purpose of defraying the expenses of said board for the fiscal
9	year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000

11	SECTION 2. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions of
12	Section 1, not more than the amounts set forth below shall be

27 Permanent: Full Time. 2 28 Part Time. 29 Time-Limited: Full Time. 30 Part Time. 31 From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits, "funds may be 32 33 expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the policies established by the State Personnel Board and any 34 35 conditions placed on such expenditures: 36 The components of the Variable Compensation Plan shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds appropriated 37 38 herein. Funds are provided to adjust the Variable Compensation 39 Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all full time 40 employees with at least six (6) months of continuous current 41 42 service, as of June 30, 1999, receive an increase of One Thousand 43 Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,500.00). Funds are provided to adjust critical job classes up to an additional One Thousand Dollars 44 45 (\$1,000.00).(c) If an employee is currently at or above the end salary 46 47 for his or her job classification, then the increase shall be built into the employee's base salary. To be eligible for any 48 increase authorized in this section, employees may not have a 49 50 current performance rating below "meets expectations" as of the effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently 51 52 receive a performance rating of "meets expectations" or above during Fiscal Year 2000 shall receive the salary increase 53 effective the date of the rating. 54 It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds 55 56 required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal 57 Year 2001 do not exceed Fiscal Year 2000 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the

agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

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Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with

- 61 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.
- No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be
- 63 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are
- 64 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this
- 65 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.
- SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 67 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the
- 68 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon
- 69 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal
- 70 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the
- 71 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law.
- 72 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 73 and after July 1, 1999.
