- 6 SECTION 1. (1) The mileage of highway specifically
- designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the 7
- total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600) 8
- miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3, Mississippi Code of 1972. 9
- 10 (2) The following highway route is designated as a state
- 11 highway and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
- Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance; and 12
- 13 such highway, together with the highways designated in Sections
- 65-3-3 and 65-3-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, and all other laws 14
- 15 adding links to the designated state highway system, are declared
- to be the state highway system of Mississippi: 16

Northern District - Kemper County 17

- That portion of Old Highway 463 from Mississippi 18
- Highway 16 northerly to Mississippi Highway 397. 19
- 20 SECTION 2. The Mississippi Transportation Commission may
- 21 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
- highway designated in Section 1 of this act in the same manner and 22
- upon the same terms and conditions as set out in Sections 65-1-75, 23
- 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3, Mississippi Code of 1972. 24
- 25 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after its passage.
