SENATE BILL NO. 2495

1 AN ACT TO DESIGNATE A CERTAIN ADDITIONAL SECTION OF HIGHWAY
2 IN KEMPER COUNTY AS A PART OF THE STATE HIGHWAY SYSTEM AND TO
3 PLACE IT UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MISSISSIPPI TRANSPORTATION
4 COMMISSION; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

6 SECTION 1. (1) The mileage of highway specifically
7 designated in subsection (2) of this section is in addition to the
8 total mileage limitation of eight thousand six hundred (8,600)
9 miles that is set out in Section 65-3-3, Mississippi Code of 1972.

10 (2) The following highway route is designated as a state
11 highway and is placed under the jurisdiction of the Mississippi
12 Transportation Commission for construction and maintenance; and
13 such highway, together with the highways designated in Sections
14 65-3-3 and 65-3-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, and all other laws
15 adding links to the designated state highway system, are declared
16 to be the state highway system of Mississippi:

17 Northern District - Kemper County

18 That portion of Old Highway 463 from Mississippi
19 Highway 16 northerly to Mississippi Highway 397.

20 SECTION 2. The Mississippi Transportation Commission may
21 maintain, construct, take over and assume jurisdiction of the
22 highway designated in Section 1 of this act in the same manner and
23 upon the same terms and conditions as set out in Sections 65-1-75,
24 65-3-3, 65-9-1 and 65-9-3, Mississippi Code of 1972.

25 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
26 and after its passage.
