- SECTION 1. Section 49-7-33, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 49-7-33. (1) It is unlawful to hunt, trap or kill any wild
- 10 bird or wild animal of any kind with the aid of bait, recordings
- 11 of bird or animal calls, or electrically amplified imitations of
- 12 calls of any kind, except a person may use electrically amplified
- 13 sound devices for hunting coyote and crow. The commission, in its
- 14 discretion, may relax the restrictions regarding the use of lures
- 15 or sound devices if a condition arises or exists, as decided by
- 16 the State Board of Health or county board of health, that may
- 17 endanger persons or livestock in a certain community, county or
- 18 area.
- 19 A person may use liquid scents for any animal or bird.
- 20 (2) The department may issue permits for hunting deer over
- 21 corn feeders. The department shall establish a reasonable fee for
- 22 the permits not to exceed Twenty Dollars (\$20.00).
- 23 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 24 and after July 1, 1999.
