7	SECTION 1. Section 37-19-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
8	amended as follows:
9	37-19-7. (1) The allowance in the minimum education program
10	for teachers' salaries in each county and separate school district
11	shall be determined and paid in accordance with the scale for
12	teachers' salaries as provided in this subsection for the number
13	of teachers employed not in excess of the number of teacher units
14	allotted. For teachers holding the following types of licenses or
15	the equivalent as determined by the State Board of Education, and
16	the following number of years of teaching experience, the scale

For teachers holding a Class A license, the minimum base pay specified in this subsection shall be increased by the sum of Four Hundred Twenty-five Dollars (\$425.00) for each year of teaching

The level of professional training of each teacher to be used

70 in establishing the salary allotment for the teachers for each

year shall be determined by the type of valid teacher's license

issued to those teachers on or before October 1 of the current

74 (2) Prior to April 15 of any school year in which a teacher
75 meets the standard requirements, any licensed teacher who shall
76 have met the requirements and acquired a Master Teacher
77 certificate from the National Board for Professional Teaching

78 Standards and who is employed by a local school board or the State

Board of Education as a teacher and not as an administrator shall

receive a salary supplement in the amount of Six Thousand Dollars

81 (\$6,000.00) in addition to any other compensation to which the

82 teacher may be entitled. The teacher shall be reimbursed one (1)

83 time for the actual cost of completing the process of acquiring

84 the Master Teacher certificate, regardless of whether or not the

85 process resulted in the award of the Master Teacher certificate.

86 All such salary supplements and process reimbursement shall be

87 paid directly by the State Department of Education to the local

88 school district and shall be in addition to its minimum education

89 program allotments and not a part thereof in accordance with

91 subject to appropriation by the Legislature. Local school

92 districts shall not reduce the local supplement paid to any

103	a salary supplement in the amount of Six Thousand Dollars
104	(\$6,000.00), in addition to any other compensations to which the
105	counselor may be entitled. The counselor shall be reimbursed one
106	(1) time for an amount equal to the reimbursement cost paid to
107	individuals acquiring a Master Teacher certificate from the
