4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. A person commits the offense of a terroristic
6	threat when he threatens to commit any crime of violence or to
7	burn or damage property with the purpose of terrorizing another or
8	of causing the evacuation of a building, place of assembly, or
9	facility of public transportation or otherwise causing serious
10	public inconvenience, or in reckless disregard of the risk of
11	causing such terror or inconvenience. No person shall be
12	convicted under this subsection on the uncorroborated testimony of
13	the party to whom the threat is communicated. A person convicted
14	of the offense of a terroristic threat shall be guilty of a
15	misdemeanor and shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five
16	Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) or by imprisonment for not more than
17	one (1) year, or both.
18	SECTION 2. (1) A person commits the offense of a
19	terroristic act when:

- (a) He uses a bomb, burning or flaming cross or other 20
- burning or flaming symbol or flambeau or other incendiary device 21
- 22 with the intent to terrorize; or
- (b) While not in the commission of a lawful act, he 23
- shoots at or throws an object at any conveyance which is being 24
- operated or which is occupied by passengers or at any occupied 25
- 26 building with the intent to terrorize one or more occupants of the

- 27 conveyance or building.
- 28 (2) A person convicted of the offense of a terroristic act
- 29 shall be guilty of a felony and shall be punished by a fine of not
- 30 more than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) or by imprisonment for
- 31 not more than five (5) years, or both.
- 32 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 33 and after its passage.
