SENATE BILL NO. 2539

- AN ACT ADOPTING "MISSISSIPPI SONG" BY JIM WEATHERLY AS THE OFFICIAL STATE SONG; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 3 WHEREAS, the promotion of the best interests of the State of
- 4 Mississippi requires that the state have an officially recognized
- 5 state song which will instill pride in all Mississippians; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the present official song, "Go, Mississippi," which
- 7 was adopted by the Legislature in House Concurrent Resolution No.
- 8 67 (1962 Regular Session), has served its purpose but is not now
- 9 representative of the quickening pace of the development of the
- 10 State of Mississippi; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Legislature desires to recognize the words and
- 12 music of "Mississippi Song" as the official song of the State of
- 13 Mississippi; NOW, THEREFORE,
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 15 $\underline{\text{SECTION 1.}}$ (1) The lyrics and music in the song entitled
- 16 "Mississippi Song" by Jim Weatherly is hereby designated as the
- 17 official song of the State of Mississippi.
- 18 (2) The Division of Tourism of the Department of Economic
- 19 and Community Development, all other agencies of the state and all
- 20 persons, firms or organizations interested in promoting the
- 21 welfare of the State of Mississippi are specifically authorized
- 22 and empowered to make use of the state song, "Mississippi Song,"
- 23 in promoting and advancing the State of Mississippi and its
- 24 citizens.
- 25 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 26 and after July 1, 1999.
