COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2541

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9-7-123, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
AUTHORIZE DEPUTY CIRCUIT CLERKS TO GIVE SURETY BONDS BEFORE
ENTERING THE DUTIES OF THE APPOINTMENT; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 9-7-123, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

7 9-7-123. (1) The clerk of the circuit court shall have 8 power, with the approbation of the court, or of the judge in 9 vacation, to appoint one or more deputies, who shall take the oath of office and may give bond, and who thereupon shall have power to 10 do and perform all the acts and duties which their principal may 11 12 lawfully do; such approval, when given by the judge in vacation, 13 shall be in writing, and shall be entered on the minutes of the court at the next term. 14

(2) Each deputy clerk of the circuit court, before he enters 15 upon the duties of the appointment, may give bond, with sufficient 16 surety, to be payable, conditioned and approved as provided by 17 law, in a penalty equal to three percent (3%) of the sum of all 18 the state and county taxes shown by the assessment rolls and the 19 20 levies to have been collectible in the county for the year immediately preceding the commencement of the term of office for 21 22 the circuit clerk. However, such bond shall not exceed the amount of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00). And he may give 23 additional bond from time to time, for the faithful application of 24 all monies coming into his hands by law or order of the court; but 25 such additional bonds shall be cumulative security, and the 26

28 hands of the deputy clerk by law or order of the court. The board

- 29 of supervisors may, in its discretion, pay the cost of the bond
- 30 <u>authorized in this subsection (2).</u>

31 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 32 and after July 1, 1999.
