- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 41-86-5, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 7 amended as follows:
- 41-86-5. As used in Sections 41-86-5 through 41-86-17, the 8
- following definitions shall have the meanings ascribed in this 9
- 10 section, unless the context indicates otherwise:
- (a) "Act" means the Mississippi Children's Health Care 11
- 12 Act.
- "Administering agency" means the agency designated 13 (b)
- by the Mississippi Children's Health Insurance Program Commission 14
- to administer the program. 15
- "Board" means the State and Public School Employees 16
- 17 Health Insurance Management Board created under Section 25-15-303.
- "Child" means an individual who is under nineteen 18
- (19) years of age who is not eligible for Medicaid benefits and is 19
- 2.0 not covered by other health insurance.
- (e) "Commission" means the Mississippi Children's 2.1
- 22 Health Insurance Program Commission created by Section 41-86-7.
- "Covered benefits" means the types of health care 23
- 24 benefits and services provided to eligible recipients under the
- 25 Children's Health Care Program.
- 26 "Division" means the Division of Medicaid in the
- Office of the Governor. 2.7
- "Low-income child" means a child whose family 28 (h)
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- 29 income does not exceed one hundred fifty percent (150%) of the
- 30 poverty level for a family of the size involved.
- 31 (i) "Plan" means the State Child Health Plan.
- 32 (j) "Program" means the Children's Health Care Program
- 33 established by Sections 41-86-5 through 41-86-17.
- 34 (k) "Recipient" means a person who is eligible for
- 35 assistance under the program.
- 36 (1) "State Child Health Plan" means the permanent plan
- 37 that sets forth the manner and means by which the State of
- 38 Mississippi will provide health care assistance to eligible
- 39 uninsured, low-income children consistent with the provisions of
- 40 Title XXI of the federal Social Security Act, as amended.
- 41 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 42 and after July 1, 1999.
