32 SECTION 2. The money under the provisions of Section 1 shall 33 be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the special 34 fund to the credit of the Department of Public Safety or the 35 proper special fund, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal 36 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants 37 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer 38 or officers in the manner provided by law.

39 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 40 and after July 1, 1999.
