SENATE BILL NO. 2601

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-37-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO REQUIRE THE LEGISLATURE TO APPROPRIATE \$20,000,000.00 THROUGH 2 3 CALENDAR YEAR 2003 TO THE LOCAL SYSTEM BRIDGE REPLACEMENT AND 4 REHABILITATION FUND IF THE OFFICIAL GENERAL FUND REVENUE ESTIMATE FOR THE SUCCEEDING FISCAL YEAR FOR WHICH APPROPRIATIONS ARE BEING 5 MADE REFLECTS A GROWTH IN GENERAL FUND REVENUES OF 3% OR MORE FOR б 7 THAT SUCCEEDING FISCAL YEAR; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT 8 ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

10 SECTION 1. Section 65-37-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 11 amended as follows:

65-37-13. (1) There is created in the State Treasury a 12 special fund to be designated as the "Local System Bridge 13 Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund." The fund shall consist of 14 15 such monies as the Legislature appropriates pursuant to subsection 16 (2) of this section and such other monies as the Legislature may 17 designate for deposit in the fund. Monies in the fund may be 18 expended upon legislative appropriation in accordance with the provisions of Section 65-37-1 through 65-37-15. 19

(2) (a) During each regular legislative session held in 20 calendar years 1995, 1996, 1997 and 1998, if the official General 21 Fund revenue estimate for the succeeding fiscal year for which 22 23 appropriations are being made reflects a growth in General Fund revenues of three percent (3%) or more for that succeeding fiscal 24 25 year, then the Legislature shall appropriate Twenty-five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00) from the State General Fund for deposit 26 27 in the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund. 28 (b) During each regular legislative session held in calendar years 1999, 2000, 2001, 2002 and 2003, if the official 29

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30 <u>General Fund revenue estimate for the succeeding fiscal year for</u> 31 <u>which appropriations are being made reflects a growth in General</u> 32 <u>Fund revenues of three percent (3%) or more for that succeeding</u> 33 <u>fiscal year, then the Legislature shall appropriate Twenty Million</u> 34 <u>Dollars (\$20,000,000.00) from the State General Fund for deposit</u> 35 <u>in the Local System Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation Fund.</u>

36 (3) Such monies as are deposited in the fund under the 37 provisions of this section may be expended upon requisition 38 therefor by the State Aid Engineer in accordance with the 39 provisions of Sections 65-37-1 through 65-37-15. Unexpended 40 amounts remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall 41 not lapse into the State General Fund, and any interest earned on 42 amounts in the fund shall be deposited to the credit of the fund.

43 (4) Monies in the Local System Bridge Replacement and
44 Rehabilitation Fund shall be allocated and become available for
45 distribution to counties in accordance with the formula prescribed
46 in Section 65-37-3 beginning January 1, 1995, on a

47 project-by-project basis. Monies in the special fund may not be 48 used or expended for any purpose except as authorized under 49 Sections 65-37-1 through 65-37-15.

50 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 51 and after its passage.
