SENATE BILL NO. 2630

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A REBATE TO CONTRACTORS WHO BUILD CERTAIN 1 RESIDENCES THAT SCORE 86 POINTS OR MORE ON THE NATIONAL UNIFORM 2 3 HOME ENERGY RATING SYSTEM SCALE OF ENERGY EFFICIENCY; TO PROVIDE 4 THAT THE AMOUNT OF THE REBATE SHALL BE FIFTY PERCENT OF THE AMOUNT OF THE SALES TAX THAT WAS LEVIED AND COLLECTED ON THE SALE OF THE MATERIALS PURCHASED BY THE CONTRACTOR AND USED IN THE CONSTRUCTION 5 б 7 OF THE RESIDENCE; TO REQUIRE THE TESTING AND CERTIFICATION OF THE ENERGY EFFICIENCY OF SUCH RESIDENCES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 10 SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section: 11 12 (a) "Accredited HERS organization" means Energy Rated 13 Homes of Mississippi or other organizations that are accredited by the Energy Division of the Department of Economic and Community 14 15 Development to test homes and certify scores on the national uniform HERS scale of energy efficiency. 16 (b) "HERS" means Home Energy Rating System. 17 "Qualified residence" means any building 18 (C) constructed as a residence that is intended to be occupied by four 19 20 (4) families or less. (2) A contractor who builds a qualified residence that 21 scores eighty-six (86) points or higher on the national uniform 22 23 HERS scale of energy efficiency as recognized by the United States Department of Energy and the Energy Division of the Mississippi 24 25 Department of Economic and Community Development, shall be entitled to receive a rebate in the amount of fifty percent (50%) 26 27 of the amount of the sales tax that was levied and collected on 28 the sale of the materials purchased by the contractor and used in

29 the construction of the qualified residence.

30 (3) An accredited HERS organization shall conduct diagnostic

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40 (4) The contractor shall submit the certificate to the State Tax Commission, together with documentation satisfactory to the 41 42 State Tax Commission of the amount of sales tax levied and 43 collected on the materials purchased by the contractor and used in the construction of the qualified residence. Upon a finding by 44 the State Tax Commission that the certificate and the 45 46 documentation submitted are proper sufficient, and that the 47 certificate indicates that the qualified home scored eighty-six (86) points or higher on the national uniform HERS scale of energy 48 49 efficiency as recognized by the United States Department of Energy and the Energy Division of the Mississippi Department of Economic 50 51 and Community Development, the contractor shall be paid the amount of the rebate to which he is entitled. 52

53 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 54 and after July 1, 1999.

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
