- 6 SECTION 1. Section 11-46-15, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

- 11-46-15. (1) In any claim or suit for damages against a 8
- governmental entity or its employee brought under the provisions 9
- 10 of this chapter, the liability shall not exceed the following for
- all claims arising out of a single occurrence for all damages 11
- 12 permitted under this chapter:
- 13 (a) For claims or causes of action arising from acts or
- omissions occurring on or after July 1, 1993, but before July 1, 14
- 15 1997, the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00);
- (b) For claims or causes of action arising from acts or 16
- omissions occurring on or after July 1, 1997, but before July 1, 17
- 2001, the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00); 18
- (c) For claims or causes of action arising from acts or 19
- 20 omissions occurring on or after July 1, 2001, the sum of Five
- Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00). 21
- 22 (2) No judgment against a governmental entity or its
- employee for any act or omission for which immunity is waived 23
- 24 under this chapter shall include an award for exemplary or
- 25 punitive damages or for interest prior to or after judgment, or an
- 26 award of attorney's fees unless attorney's fees are specifically
- authorized by law. 2.7

- 28 (3) Except as otherwise provided in Section 11-46-17(4), in
- 29 any suit brought under the provisions of this chapter, if the
- 30 verdict which is returned, when added to costs and any attorney's
- 31 fees authorized by law, would exceed the maximum dollar amount of
- 32 liability provided in subsection (1) of this section, the court
- 33 shall reduce the verdict accordingly and enter judgment in an
- 34 amount not to exceed the maximum dollar amount of liability
- 35 provided in subsection (1) of this section.
- 36 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 37 and after July 1, 1999.
