## SENATE BILL NO. 2686

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 25-1-98, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO
PROVIDE FOR EXTENDED OFFICE HOURS FOR CERTAIN STATE AGENCIES
PROVIDING SERVICES TO LOW-INCOME FAMILIES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR
STAFF DURING SUCH EXTENDED OFFICE HOURS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
SECTION 1. Section 25-1-98, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
amended as follows:

8 25-1-98. (1) In addition to any other times required by statute, all state offices shall be open and staffed for the 9 10 normal conduct of business from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except on legal holidays as set forth in Section 11 12 3-3-7. The Governor may designate certain state offices and institutions as providers of essential services and require that 13 they be open and staffed on legal holidays. The Board of 14 15 Directors of the Mississippi Industries for the Blind may, in its discretion, require that its offices and operations be open and 16 17 staffed on legal holidays. Employees required to work on legal holidays shall earn compensatory leave under the provisions of 18 Section 25-3-92. No employee shall receive additional vacation or 19 20 sick leave benefits for working on a legal holiday, nor shall this section be construed to authorize any additional compensation as 21 22 an alternative to the accrual of compensatory leave except as specifically provided for in a legislative appropriation. 23 The 24 provisions of this section shall not be construed to limit the 25 hours of operation of any agency or to abrogate any action taken 26 during hours other than those stated, nor shall these provisions apply to any offices that do not customarily stay open five (5) 27

S. B. No. 2686 99\SS02\R943 PAGE 1 28 days a week. The provisions of this section shall not apply to 29 the military department of the State of Mississippi or to the 30 armories, field training sites, air bases or other installations 31 of the Mississippi National Guard.

32 (2) A workday for a state employee in a full-time employment 33 position shall be eight (8) hours in duration at a minimum exclusive of time off for meals. The appointing authority shall 34 develop work schedules which ensure that each full-time employee 35 works a full workday and shall provide the State Auditor with a 36 copy of the regular work schedule of the appointing authority. 37 38 (3) In addition to any other times required by statute, the following state agencies providing services to low-income families 39 40 shall be open and staffed for the normal conduct of business from 8:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m., Monday through Saturday: (a) the 41 Department of Human Services; (b) the Division of Medicaid; (c) 42 the State Department of Health; and (d) the Mississippi Employment 43 Security Commission. The administrative head of the appropriate 44 divisions and bureaus of said agencies shall assign employees to 45 flexible working hours in order to accommodate the extended office 46 47 hours prescribed herein, and no employee assigned to such extended office hours shall receive additional compensation, vacation leave 48 or compensatory leave benefits for staffing the office during such 49 50 period of time. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 51
