SENATE BILL NO. 2702

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT 2 OF PUBLIC SAFETY FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING FUNDS FOR PROGRAMS 3 TO BE CONDUCTED BY A LOCAL YOUTH ONLY ORGANIZATION CHARTERED BY A 4 NATIONAL YOUTH ONLY DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 5 2000.

б BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 8 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi 9 10 Department of Public Safety for the purpose of providing funds for programs to be conducted by a local youth only development 11 organization chartered by a national youth only development 12 13 organization that provides opportunities for children between the 14 ages of six (6) and eighteen (18), which shall be expended as specified in Section 2 of this act, for the fiscal year beginning 15 July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... \$ 6,300,000.00. 16 2. (1) The Criminal Justice Planning Division of 17 SECTION the Department of Public Safety shall expend money appropriated by 18 Section 1 of this act for programs to be conducted by a local 19 youth only development organization chartered by a national youth 20 21 only development organization that provides opportunities for children between the ages of (6) and eighteen (18), with the main 22 23 focus on disadvantaged, at-risk youth. These programs must include, but are not limited to character and leadership 24 development, education and career development, health and life 25 skills, appreciation of the arts, sports fitness and recreation, 26 like the Boys & Girls Clubs. 27

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(2) The money appropriated by Section 1 of this act shall be 28 expended by the Criminal Planning Division as follows: 29 30 (a) To award matching grants to fund programs to extend the outreach of existing clubs and 31 32 improve existing programs, not to exceed One Hundred Seventy-five Dollars (\$175.00) for each 33 34 child served by the club. To provide matching funds for the establishment 35 (b) of new local clubs in communities in the state, 36 37 not to exceed Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) per club. 38 SECTION 3. The money appropriated by this act shall be paid 39 by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General fund 40 not otherwise appropriated, upon warrants issued by the State 41 Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his 42 43 warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or 44 officers in the manner provided by law.

45 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 46 and after July 1, 1999.

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
