SENATE BILL NO. 2714

- AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION TO BE CODIFIED WITHIN CHAPTER 3 OF TITLE 71, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE THAT
- 3 NO WORKERS' COMPENSATION SHALL BE PAID TO AN EMPLOYEE WHILE THE
- 4 EMPLOYEE IS INCARCERATED; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 7 chapter, an injured worker is not eligible to receive compensation
- 8 benefits or medical expenses for periods of time during which the
- 9 worker is incarcerated for the commission of a crime, unless the
- 10 injured worker had been "found" to have a permanent and total loss
- 11 of wage earning capacity which was attributable to the work
- 12 related injury.
- 13 (2) As used in this section, an individual is not
- 14 "incarcerated" if the individual is on parole or work release
- 15 status.
- 16 (3) If upon appeal, such conviction is overturned, the
- 17 benefits suspended during the period of incarceration shall be
- 18 reinstated.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this act shall be codified as a
- 20 separate section within Chapter 3 of Title 71, Mississippi Code of
- 21 1972.
- 22 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 1999.
