## SENATE BILL NO. 2716

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-20, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 2 PROVIDE THAT PERSONS WHO ARE EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENT OF 3 PROCURING A HUNTING LICENSE BECAUSE OF DISABILITY SHALL NOT BE 4 EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENT OF SATISFACTORILY COMPLETING AN 5 APPROVED HUNTER EDUCATION COURSE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-20, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 49-7-20. (1) It is unlawful for any person born on or after 9 10 January 1, 1972, to procure any hunting license \* \* \*, or to hunt 11 if the person is exempt from procuring a hunting license because of disability as authorized under Section 49-7-5(2)(a), unless the 12 13 person has been issued certification of satisfactory completion of 14 a hunter education course approved by the department. (2) It is unlawful for any person to issue any license 15 16 provided by the department to any person born on or after January 1, 1972, unless the purchaser has provided valid certification of 17 satisfactory completion of a hunter education course approved by 18 the department. 19 (3) It is unlawful for any person to fraudulently obtain a 20 21 hunter education certification. The department may revoke any hunting license or hunter 2.2 (4) education certification upon determination that the holder was not 23 entitled to issuance or obtained the license or certification by 24 25 any fraudulent means. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 26 and after July 1, 1999. 27
