## SENATE BILL NO. 2719

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 9-7-44, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CREATE AN ADDITIONAL JUDGESHIP FOR THE SIXTEENTH CIRCUIT COURT 1 2 3 DISTRICT; TO PROVIDE FOR THE ELECTION THEREOF; AND FOR RELATED 4 PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 SECTION 1. Section 9-7-44, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 7 amended as follows: 9-7-44. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, 8 there shall be two (2) judges for the Sixteenth Circuit Court 9 10 District. (2) From and after January 1, 2000, there shall be three (3) 11 judges for the Sixteenth Circuit Court District. The initial term 12 for the third judgeship created under this section shall begin on 13 January 1, 2000, and shall end at the same time as the terms of 14 circuit judges generally. The initial holder of the third 15 16 judgeship shall not be appointed but shall be elected at a special election to be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday of 17 November, 1999, and all candidates therefor shall file their 18 19 intent to be a candidate and pay the fee provided in Section 20 23-15-977 not later than thirty (30) days prior to the general election; the election of the initial holder of the third 21 judgeship shall otherwise be as required by law. 22 SECTION 2. The Attorney General of the State of Mississippi 23 is directed to submit this act, immediately upon approval by the 24 25 Governor, or upon approval by the Legislature subsequent to a 26 veto, to the Attorney General of the United States or to the 27 United States District Court for the District of Columbia in

30 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 31 and after the date it is effectuated under Section 5 of the Voting 32 Rights Act of 1965, as amended and extended.
