33 From the funds provided in the budget category "Personal 34 Services: Salaries, Wages and Fringe Benefits," funds may be 35 expended for the following purposes, in compliance with the 36 policies established by the State Personnel Board and any 37 conditions placed on such expenditures:

The components of the Variable Compensation Plan 38 (a) 39 shall be maintained within the constraints of the funds 40 appropriated herein. Unless otherwise permitted by law, no single event, including promotion, reclassification or reallocation, 41 shall exceed the greater of (1) the difference between the 42 43 starting salary (start step) of the current classification and the 44 new classification added to the employee's current salary (current step), or (2) the salary that could be paid to an equally 45 46 qualified, newly hired employee. If an eligible employee is currently at or above the end salary for his or her job 47 48 classification, then the increase authorized by subparagraphs (b), (c) and (d) shall be built into the employee's base salary. To be 49 50 eligible, employees may not have a current performance rating 51 below "meets expectations" (2.0), as of the effective date of the increase. Employees who subsequently receive a performance rating 52 53 of "meets expectations" or above during Fiscal Year 1999 shall receive the salary increase effective the date of the rating. 54 55 (b) Funds are provided to adjust the Variable

56 Compensation Plan, including realignment, to ensure that all full 57 time employees receive a minimum increase of Six Hundred Dollars 58 (\$600.00) and not more than Nine Hundred Dollars (\$900.00), to the 59 next higher step.

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(c) Funds are provided for MH-Direct Care Worker

It is the intention of the 63 Legislature that MH-Direct Care Worker Classifications increases 64 resulting from the provisions of Senate Bill No. 2100, 1997 65 Regular Session, may be fully implemented as funds become 66 available.

(d) Funds are provided for a Nine Hundred Dollar
(\$900.00) increase for Information Technology positions. Agencies
may effect additional increases in accordance with the Information
Technology Special Compensation Plan established by the State
Personnel Board as funds become available.

It is the agency's responsibility to make certain that funds required to be appropriated for "Personal Services" for Fiscal Year 2000 do not exceed Fiscal Year 1999 funds appropriated for that purpose unless programs or positions are added to the agency's budget by the Mississippi Legislature.

77 Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with 78 the terms, conditions and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

83 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 84 and after its passage.
