- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 6 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Any licensed motor vehicle dealer shall disclose
- 7 upon request by any prospective buyer or purchaser, prior to sale
- 8 or trade, all repairs to a motor vehicle which were performed at
- 9 the dealer's place of business and which resulted in repairs or
- 10 repair estimates that exceeded Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00).
- 11 Such disclosure shall be in writing and shall require the
- 12 prospective buyer's or purchaser's signature acknowledging the
- 13 disclosure of repairs.
- 14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 15 and after July 1, 1999.
