BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
8	SECTION 1. Section 29-9-17, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
9	amended as follows:
10	29-9-17. (1) If any officer or employee of any state agency
11	shall refuse or fail to make any inventory or supplemental
12	inventory thereto as required herein, or to do so in the manner
13	prescribed by the State Auditor, the State Auditor shall proceed
14	to make, or cause to be made, the inventory or supplemental
15	inventory; and the expense thereof shall be personally borne by
16	said officer or employee, and he shall be responsible on his
17	official bond for the payment of the expense.
18	(2) In the event that an examination conducted pursuant to
19	Section 29-9-13 finds items that are included on an agency's
20	inventory which are missing and otherwise unaccounted for, the
21	State Auditor has the authority to proceed under the provisions of
22	Section 7-7-211 to recover the value of the missing items. The
23	demand shall be made against the head of the agency, the agency's
24	property officer and/or the appropriate officer or employee, if
25	identified. Provided, however, that any such demand against the
26	head of a state university shall not be personally borne by such
27	individual if the property loss occurred prior to his term of
28	office.
