SENATE BILL NO. 2797

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-33-67, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THOSE PLAYING BINGO TO BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OF AGE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 97-33-67, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 5 amended as follows:
- 6 97-33-67. (1) (a) No licensee shall hold, operate or
- 7 conduct any bingo game more often than for two (2) sessions within
- 8 one (1) day and more often than eight (8) sessions in any one (1)
- 9 week. Any licensee who holds no more than one (1) session per
- 10 week shall be entitled to conduct one (1) six-hour session per
- 11 week. Notwithstanding the provisions of this paragraph,
- 12 pull-tabs, video pull-tabs or video bingo games may be played for
- 13 up to eighty (80) hours per week.
- 14 (b) No licensee shall hold, operate or conduct any
- 15 bingo game in more than one (1) physical location. Any bingo
- 16 operation for which a license has been issued by the Gaming
- 17 Commission on or after April 1, 1995, and which is located within
- 18 one thousand five hundred (1,500) feet of a school or public
- 19 library, shall not conduct bingo sessions during the hours of the
- 20 school day or during library hours.
- 21 (2) The total amount of prizes which may be awarded in any
- 22 one (1) session by a licensee shall not exceed Seven Thousand Five
- 23 Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) in cash or other thing or things of
- 24 value, except as otherwise provided in Section 97-33-59 and except
- 25 that the total amount of prizes which may be awarded in any one
- 26 (1) session shall not exceed Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) if

- 27 only one (1) session is held in any one (1) week. The Seven
- 28 Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) and the Eight Thousand
- 29 Dollars (\$8,000.00) limits do not include payback of pull-tabs or
- 30 electronic representations. The commission shall establish by
- 31 rule the method of calculating the value of anything offered as a
- 32 prize.
- 33 (3) Each licensee shall designate a supervisor and a
- 34 sufficient number of alternate supervisors to be in charge of and
- 35 primarily responsible for each session of a bingo game. Such
- 36 individual shall be familiar with the provisions of Sections
- 37 97-33-51 through 97-33-203 and the rules and regulations of the
- 38 commission. Such individual, or alternate who shall be designated
- 39 as the bingo supervisor, shall supervise all activities of such
- 40 session and be responsible for the conduct of all games of such
- 41 session. The supervisor shall be present at all times on the
- 42 premises during the session.
- 43 (4) No licensee shall purchase or otherwise obtain any
- 44 gaming supplies or equipment from any distributor, operator or
- 45 manufacturer until it has first determined that the individual
- 46 selling or otherwise offering such supplies or equipment has a
- 47 valid license issued by the commission.
- 48 (5) No licensee shall allow any person under eighteen (18)
- 49 years of age to assist in the holding, operation or conduct of any
- 50 bingo game. No licensee shall allow any person under eighteen
- 51 (18) years of age to play a bingo game * * * and a licensee may
- 52 prohibit all persons under eighteen (18) years from entering the
- 53 licensed premises by posting a written notice to that effect on
- 54 the premises.
- 55 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 56 and after July 1, 1999.
