AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION TO THE MISSISSIPPI NATIONAL GUARD FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW ARMORY AT VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI, 1 2 3 AND BROOKHAVEN, MISSISSIPPI, FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 7 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi National Guard 8 for the purpose of constructing a new armory at Vicksburg, 9 Mississippi, and to authorize the use of part of the funds to match any federal funds that may be available to the state for 10 armory construction, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, 11 12 and ending June 30, 2000..... \$1,552,000.00. 13 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much there of as may be necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the State General 14 Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Mississippi National Guard 15 for the purpose of constructing a new armory at Brookhaven, 16 Mississippi, and to authorize the use of part of such funds to 17 match any federal funds that may be available to the State for 18 armory construction, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, 19 20 and ending June 30, 2000..... \$1,100,000.00. 21 SECTION 3. The acceptance and expenditure of federal 22 government funds which may become available to the Mississippi National Guard for construction purposes is authorized and 23 approved, provided the receipts and expenditures are reported and 24 25 otherwise handled in accordance with the state budget law, which is Section 27-103-101 et seq. and Section 27-104-1 et seq., 26

SECTION 4. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 28 29 necessary, is appropriated out of any money in the special fund in the State Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi National 30 31 guard, for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of applicable statutes and federal/state construction agreements for 32 33 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 34 2000.....\$9,593,000.00. 35 SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the Adjutant General may transfer excess funds among the armory 36 construction projects set forth in Section 1 and Section 2. 37 SECTION 6. The money appropriated under the provisions of 38 39 Section 1 and Section 2 shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, 40 and the money appropriated under the provisions of Section 4 shall 41 42 be paid by the State treasurer out of the special fund to the credit of the Mississippi National Guard, upon warrants issued by 43 the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue 44 his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, 45 46 officer or officers in the manner provided by law.

47 SECTION 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from 48 and after July 1, 1999.
