COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 2832

AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW CODE SECTION TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTION 41-26-103, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO DEVELOP ANNUALLY A LIST OF POTENTIALLY NON-VIABLE 3 COMMUNITY PUBLIC WATER SYSTEMS AND TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF 5 HEALTH TO OFFER THOSE SYSTEMS TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE AT NO COST TO THE SYSTEM; TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH TO NOTIFY THE PUBLIC UTILITIES STAFF IF THE SYSTEM REFUSES THE ASSISTANCE OR 6 7 8 FAILS TO RESPOND; TO AUTHORIZE THE PUBLIC UTILITY STAFF TO CONDUCT 9 A FINANCIAL OR MANAGERIAL REVIEW, OR BOTH, ON SYSTEMS REFUSING ASSISTANCE OR FAILING TO RESPOND; TO AUTHORIZE THE PUBLIC 10 11 UTILITIES STAFF TO ASSESS AND COLLECT THE COSTS OF THE REVIEW OR REVIEWS FROM THE APPROPRIATE SYSTEM; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 12 13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 14 SECTION 1. The following shall be codified as Section 41-26-103, Mississippi Code of 1972: 15 16 41-26-103. (1) The department shall develop annually a list of community public water systems which the department, after 17 consultation with the Public Utilities Staff created in Section 18 77-2-1, considers to be potentially non-viable or experiencing 19 20 other problems which may make the system potentially non-viable. 21 The list shall state the areas of concern and shall be prioritized based upon viability considerations. The department shall notify 2.2 23 at a minimum those systems shown in top ten (10) places on the 24 list and shall offer to provide those systems with technical assistance pertaining to the areas of concern for that system at 25 26 no cost to the system. If the notified community public water 27 system refuses the offer of technical assistance at no cost to the 28 system or fails to respond within sixty (60) days of the written 29 offer, the department shall notify the Public Utilities Staff in 30 writing. (2) Following receipt of notification from the department 31

- 32 that a community public water system has refused to accept
- 33 technical assistance or failed to respond, the Public Utilities
- 34 Staff may conduct a financial or managerial review, or both, of
- 35 the system and shall submit a copy of any report to the
- 36 department. The Public Utilities Staff may assess and collect the
- 37 cost of any financial or management review, or both, from the
- 38 community public water system on which the review or reviews are
- 39 conducted.
- 40 (3) This section shall stand repealed from and after July 1,
- 41 2002.
- 42 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 43 and after July 1, 1999.
