SENATE BILL NO. 2856

AN ACT TO CREATE NEW CODE SECTIONS TO BE CODIFIED AS SECTIONS 1 57-81-1 AND 57-81-3, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CREATE AND EMPOWER THE MISSISSIPPI SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY COMMISSION TO 2 3 4 STRENGTHEN STATE AWARENESS AND SUPPORT OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY 5 INNOVATIONS AND TO ADVISE THE GOVERNOR AND THE LEGISLATURE ON SUCH ISSUES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 6 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. The following provision shall be codified as 8 Section 57-81-1, Mississippi Code of 1972: 9 <u>57-81-1.</u> (1) There is hereby created the Mississippi 10 11 Science and Technology Commission which shall be constituted as follows: 12 13 (a) Six (6) representatives of private business appointed by the Governor. 14 A representative of state institutions of higher (b) 15 16 learning appointed by the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of Higher Learning. 17 18 (c) Two (2) representatives of the Mississippi Department of Economic and Community Development appointed by the 19 Executive Director of the Department of Economic and Community 20 21 Development. (d) That person designated by the Governor as his 22 23 advisor for economic development. (e) A representative of community colleges appointed by 24 25 the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges. 26 (f) Two (2) representatives of federal laboratories 27 located in this state appointed by the Governor pursuant to recommendations made by Mississippi members of the Federal 28

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30 (g) A member of the Mississippi Senate appointed by the
31 President of the Senate, to be a non-voting member.
32 (h) A member of the Mississippi House of
33 Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House, to be a
34 non-voting member.
35 (i) Two (2) representatives of the Mississippi Research
36 Consortium appointed by the Chairman of the Mississippi Research

37 Consortium.
38 (j) Two (2) representatives of the University Research
39 Authority appointed by the President of the University Research

40 Authority.

41 (k) The President of the Institute for Technology42 Development, or his designee.

43 (1) The Executive Director of the Mississippi44 Enterprise for Technology, or his designee.

(m) Two (2) persons actively involved in educating
Grades K through 12 children, who shall be appointed by the State
Board of Education.

48 (2) Appointed members shall serve for a two-year term,
49 subject to the will and pleasure of the appointing authority, and
50 may be reappointed to consecutive terms.

(3) The commission shall elect one (1) member to serve as 51 chairman. The commission shall meet upon the call of the chairman 52 in Jackson, Mississippi, or at such other places in the state 53 designated by the commission. Members of the commission shall 54 55 receive no compensation for their services but may be reimbursed for their actual and necessary expenses incurred in the 56 57 performance of their duties as provided in Section 25-3-41, 58 Mississippi Code of 1972, for state officers and employees. (4) The commission is established for the following 59 60 purposes:

(a) To facilitate the development, coordination and
promotion of state science and technology programs related to
business and economic development.

science and technology appropriate to the needs of industry and
the Mississippi economy.

(5) The Department of Economic and Community Development may
provide financial and staff support as needed by the commission.
(6) The provisions of this chapter supersede Executive Order
72 726 signed by the Governor on January 21, 1993.

73 SECTION 2. The following provision shall be codified as
74 Section 57-81-3, Mississippi Code of 1972:

75 <u>57-81-3.</u> All new programs authorized in this chapter are
76 subject to the availability of funds specifically appropriated
77 therefor by the Legislature.

78 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from 79 and after its passage.

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
