BE IT ENACTED BY THE б LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 8 SECTION 1. Section 65-1-165, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 9 amended as follows: 65-1-165. The State Department of Transportation may execute 10 a contract with Keep Mississippi Beautiful, Inc., to develop and 11 implement a comprehensive statewide program of litter prevention. 12 The contract shall contain provisions to require that Keep 13 14 Mississippi Beautiful, Inc., will: 15 (a) Encourage and assist local communities to become certified Keep America Beautiful systems; 16 (b) Serve as a state clearinghouse of information on 17 ideas and projects to make local litter prevention programs more 18 effective; 19 20 (C) Implement statewide communication programs to alert people to the problem of littering and how it can be corrected; 21 22 (d) Coordinate an annual statewide project which will heighten public awareness of the problem of littering; 23 24 (e) Establish an annual awards program to recognize individual and community achievement in litter prevention; 25 (f) Serve as the authority which approves and disburses 26 27 financial assistance to any nonprofit corporation, county, * * * municipality or other entity as directed by the Department of 28

The financial assistance authorized in this paragraph 31 shall not exceed forty percent (40%) of the cost of the local 32 litter prevention project for which the assistance is sought; 33 Encourage donation of funds from the private sector 34 (g) to assist in defraying the operation of the litter prevention 35 program implemented under this section; and 36 37 (h) Perform all other acts and provide all other 38 services, convenient or necessary, including disbursement of financial assistance, as required by the contract with the State 39 40 Department of Transportation under this section. * * * 41 Keep Mississippi Beautiful, Inc., shall submit to the * * * 42 43 department on or before August 1 of each year a written report
