## SENATE BILL NO. 2891

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-17-28, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO DESIGNATE THE PERMIT BOARD AS THE STATE AGENCY TO ADMINISTER 2 THE STATE PERMIT PROGRAM FOR WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION UNDER THE 4 FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT; TO AMEND SECTION 49-17-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFIRM; TO AMEND SECTION 49-17-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM TO REORGANIZATION NOMENCLATURE; AND FOR 5 6 RELATED PURPOSES. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE 8 OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 10 SECTION 1. Section 49-17-28, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 11 amended as follows: 49-17-28. (1) There is created a Permit Board for the 12 purpose of issuing, reissuing, modifying, revoking or denying, 13 under the conditions, limitations and exemptions prescribed in 14 15 Section 49-17-29: (a) permits to control or prevent the discharge 16 of contaminants and wastes into the air and waters of the state; (b) permits required under the Solid Wastes Disposal Law of 1974 17 18 (Title 17, Chapter 17); (c) permits required under Sections 51-3-1 19 through 51-3-55; (d) water quality certifications and permits required by Section 401 of the federal Clean Water Act; and (e) 20 all other permits within the jurisdiction of the Permit Board. 21 The membership of the Permit Board shall be composed of the Chief 22 23 of the Bureau of Environmental Health of the State Board of Health, or his designee; the Executive Director of the Department 2.4 25 of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, or his designee; the Head of the Office of Land and Water Resources of the Department of 26 Environmental Quality, or his designee; the Supervisor of the 27 State Oil and Gas Board, or his designee; the Executive Director 28 29 of the Department of Marine Resources, or his designee; the Head

- 30 of the Office of Geology and Energy Resources of the Department of
- 31 Environmental Quality, or his designee; the Commissioner of
- 32 Agriculture and Commerce, or his designee; a retired professional
- 33 engineer knowledgeable in the engineering of water wells and water
- 34 supply systems, to be appointed by the Governor for a term
- 35 concurrent with that of the Governor and until his successor is
- 36 appointed and qualified; and a retired water well contractor, to
- 37 be appointed by the Governor for a term concurrent with that of
- 38 the Governor and until his successor is appointed and qualified.
- 39 The retired professional engineer and the retired water well
- 40 contractor shall only vote on matters pertaining to the Office of
- 41 Land and Water Resources.
- 42 (2) Members of the Permit Board who are officers and
- 43 employees of the state shall receive no compensation for their
- 44 services on the board, but other board members shall receive per
- 45 diem compensation as provided in Section 25-3-69. All board
- 46 members shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses,
- 47 including mileage, incurred in the performance of their official
- 48 duties as provided in Section 25-3-41.
- 49 SECTION 2. Section 49-17-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 50 amended as follows:
- 51 49-17-13. \* \* \* The commission is hereby designated as
- 52 the \* \* \* pollution control agency for this state to
- 53 <u>administer</u> \* \* \* federal pollution control legislation and
- 54 programs <u>and</u> interstate or regional agreements pertaining to solid
- or hazardous waste management \* \* \*. \* \*
- 56 \* \* \*
- 57 SECTION 3. Section 49-17-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 58 amended as follows:
- 59 49-17-7. (1) The Mississippi Commission on Environmental
- 60 Quality shall be the Mississippi Air and Water Pollution Control
- 61 Commission, and shall exercise the duties and responsibilities of
- 62 the Mississippi Air and Water Pollution Control Commission
- 63 through \* \* \* the Mississippi Department of Environmental
- 64 Quality \* \* \*.
- 65 (2) The words "Mississippi Air and Water Pollution Control
- 66 Commission" wherever they may appear in the laws of the State of

- 67 Mississippi shall be construed to mean the Mississippi Commission
- 68 on <u>Environmental Quality</u>.
- 69 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 70 and after its passage.
