SENATE BILL NO. 2891 (As Passed the Senate)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-17-28, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 TO DESIGNATE THE PERMIT BOARD AS THE STATE AGENCY TO ADMINISTER 2 3 THE STATE PERMIT PROGRAM FOR WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION UNDER THE 4 FEDERAL CLEAN WATER ACT AND TO REQUIRE THE PERMIT BOARD TO 5 DELEGATE THE ISSUANCE OF CERTAIN WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION TO THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY; б TO AMEND SECTION 49-17-13, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM; 7 TO AMEND SECTION 49-17-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO CONFORM TO 8 9 REORGANIZATION NOMENCLATURE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT 10 ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

SECTION 1. Section 49-17-28, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

14 49-17-28. (1) There is created a Permit Board for the purpose of issuing, reissuing, modifying, revoking or denying, 15 16 under the conditions, limitations and exemptions prescribed in 17 Section 49-17-29: (a) permits to control or prevent the discharge of contaminants and wastes into the air and waters of the state; 18 (b) permits required under the Solid Wastes Disposal Law of 1974 19 (Title 17, Chapter 17); (c) permits required under Sections 51-3-1 20 through 51-3-55; (d) water quality certifications and permits 21 required by Section 401 of the federal Clean Water Act; and (e) 22 all other permits within the jurisdiction of the Permit Board. 23 24 The membership of the Permit Board shall be composed of the Chief of the Bureau of Environmental Health of the State Board of 25 26 Health, or his designee; the Executive Director of the Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks, or his designee; the Head of the 27 Office of Land and Water Resources of the Department of 28 Environmental Quality, or his designee; the Supervisor of the 29 State Oil and Gas Board, or his designee; the Executive Director 30

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of the Department of Marine Resources, or his designee; the Head 31 32 of the Office of Geology and Energy Resources of the Department of Environmental Quality, or his designee; the Commissioner of 33 Agriculture and Commerce, or his designee; a retired professional 34 35 engineer knowledgeable in the engineering of water wells and water 36 supply systems, to be appointed by the Governor for a term 37 concurrent with that of the Governor and until his successor is appointed and qualified; and a retired water well contractor, to 38 be appointed by the Governor for a term concurrent with that of 39 the Governor and until his successor is appointed and qualified. 40 The retired professional engineer and the retired water well 41 contractor shall only vote on matters pertaining to the Office of 42 43 Land and Water Resources.

44 (2) Members of the Permit Board who are officers and 45 employees of the state shall receive no compensation for their 46 services on the board, but other board members shall receive per 47 diem compensation as provided in Section 25-3-69. All board 48 members shall be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses, 49 including mileage, incurred in the performance of their official 50 duties as provided in Section 25-3-41.

(3) In implementing the authority granted under this section 51 52 for the Permit Board to issue water quality certifications required by Section 401 of the federal Clean Water Act, the Permit 53 54 Board shall authorize the Executive Director of the Department of 55 Environmental Quality to make decisions on issuance of water quality certifications on projects which the department has 56 received no written adverse comments. A decision of the executive 57 director made under this authority shall be a decision of the 58 Permit Board and shall be subject to a formal hearing and an 59 60 appeal as provided in Section 49-17-29. SECTION 2. Section 49-17-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 61 62 amended as follows: 49-17-13. (1) The commission is hereby designated as 63 64 the * * * pollution control agency for this state to 65 administer * * * federal pollution control legislation and 66 programs and interstate or regional agreements pertaining to solid

No. 2891 99\SS26\R1153CS PAGE 2 68 (2) The commission shall have the right to call upon and 69 receive the assistance of any officer, board, department, school, 70 university or any other state agency, and officers and employees 71 thereof, for any reasonable assistance necessary or beneficial in 72 carrying out the provisions of Sections 49-17-1 through 49-17-43. 73 * * *

74 SECTION 3. Section 49-17-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 75 amended as follows:

76 49-17-7. (1) The Mississippi Commission on <u>Environmental</u> 77 <u>Quality</u> shall be the Mississippi Air and Water Pollution Control 78 Commission, and shall exercise the duties and responsibilities of 79 the Mississippi Air and Water Pollution Control Commission 80 through * * the Mississippi Department of <u>Environmental</u> 81 <u>Quality</u> * *.

82 (2) The words "Mississippi Air and Water Pollution Control
83 Commission" wherever they may appear in the laws of the State of
84 Mississippi shall be construed to mean the Mississippi Commission
85 on Environmental Quality.

86 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 87 and after its passage.
