SENATE BILL NO. 2902 (As Passed the Senate)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTIONS 69-3-109, 69-3-111 AND 69-3-113, 1 MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE SEED CERTIFICATION LAW IN 2 3 ORDER TO INCLUDE OTHER FARM PRODUCTS THAT MAY BE DEFINED BY REGULATION; TO AMEND SECTION 69-5-107, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 5 TO PROVIDE THAT A DAIRY SHOW SHALL BE HELD AT TYLERTOWN IN 6 WALTHALL COUNTY, INSTEAD OF KOSCIUSKO IN ATTALA COUNTY; AND FOR 7 RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE 8 OF MISSISSIPPI: 9 SECTION 1. Section 69-3-109, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 10 11 amended as follows: 12 69-3-109. Every person, firm, association or corporation who 13 shall issue, use or circulate any certificate, advertisement, tag, 14 seal, poster, letterhead, marking circular, written or printed 15 representation, or description of or pertaining to seeds, plants 16 or plant parts, and other farm products that may be defined by regulation, intended for propagation or sale or sold or offered 17 18 for sale wherein the words "Mississippi Certified", or "Mississippi State Certified", "State Certified", or similar words 19 20 or phrases are used or employed, or wherein are used or employed 21 signs, symbols, maps, diagrams, pictures, words or phrases 22 expressly or impliedly stating or representing that such seeds, 23 plants or plant parts, and other farm products comply with or 24 conform to the certification standards or requirements as made by

- 25 the approved state seed certifying agency of Mississippi, shall be
- 26 subject to the provisions of this article, provided that this
- 27 article shall not apply to the certification of plants or plant
- 28 products for freedom from disease or insects which is now
- 29 conducted under the authority of the Commissioner of Agriculture
- 30 and Commerce. Every issuance, use, or circulation of any
- 31 certificate or any other instrument as in this section above
- 32 described shall be deemed to be "certification" as this term is
- 33 employed in this article.
- 34 SECTION 2. Section 69-3-111, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 35 amended as follows:
- 36 69-3-111. The state seed certifying agency shall not have
- 37 the power to engage in the sale or processing of seeds, plants or
- 38 plant parts, and other farm products, or to designate any agency
- 39 or individual for these purposes except that the state seed
- 40 certifying agency may promote the sale of certified seeds in
- 41 general through advertising.
- 42 SECTION 3. Section 69-3-113, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 43 amended as follows:
- 44 69-3-113. The duly approved state seed certifying agency is
- 45 hereby vested with the full authority to establish, create and
- 46 specify rules and regulations for the designation of seeds, plants
- 47 and plant parts, and other farm products as certified or
- 48 Mississippi certified to be grown, harvested, offered for sale or
- 49 distributed. Such rules and regulations shall be approved by the
- 50 state seed board before becoming effective. No seeds, plants or
- 51 plant parts, or other farm products grown or to be grown in
- 52 Mississippi shall be eligible for certification hereunder except
- 53 by full compliance as to standards, requirements and forms of or
- 54 for certification as may be made by the duly approved state seed
- 55 certifying agency. No certification within the provisions of this

- 56 article shall be made or authorized except through the approved
- 57 state certifying agency as herein provided.
- 58 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Section 69-5-107, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 59 amended as follows:
- 60 69-5-107. Dairy shows shall be held, in addition to the
- 61 livestock shows, each fall at Verona in Lee County, at Newton in
- 62 Newton County, at <u>Tylertown</u> in <u>Walthall</u> County, and at Columbia in
- 63 Marion County, and each summer at the Neshoba County Fair in
- 64 Neshoba County, and any person in the state is entitled to
- 65 participate in either of the dairy shows. The dairy shows shall
- 66 be supervised and handled in the same manner as provided for
- 67 livestock shows in Section 69-5-105, and each of the five (5)
- 68 dairy shows herein provided for shall receive such part of the
- 69 monies appropriated for the Mississippi Livestock Show as shall be
- 70 specified in the act making such appropriation.
- 71 SECTION $\underline{5}$. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 72 and after July 1, 1999.
