1 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO 2 ESTABLISH A PROGRAM THAT BRINGS TOGETHER REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE 3 FIELDS OF EDUCATION AND JUVENILE JUSTICE TO DEVELOP MEANS TO 4 DECREASE THE NUMBER OF JUVENILE OFFENDERS; AND FOR RELATED 5 PURPOSES. б BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 7 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The State Department of Education shall establish 8 and implement a program that brings together representatives of the State Department of Education, the juvenile justice system, 9 10 education organizations, legislators and other parties deemed 11 appropriate by the department for the purpose of developing means to decrease the number of juvenile offenders. Participants in the 12 13 program shall coordinate their efforts to promote educational 14 practices that discourage delinquent or criminal behavior, provide 15 for adequate training of school personnel in current effective discipline procedures and encourage creative solutions to new and 16 continuing problems concerning juvenile behavior. 17 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 18

19 and after July 1, 1999.
