12	contractor or motor vehicle repair shop * * * *.
13	(2) The most an insurer shall be required to pay for the
14	repair of a damaged vehicle * * * is the lowest amount that such
15	vehicle * * * could be properly and fairly repaired or replaced by
16	a contractor or repair shop within a reasonable geographical or
17	trade area of the insured. This subsection (2) shall not apply
18	when glass repair or replacement is the only repair needed to the
19	damaged vehicle.
