SENATE BILL NO. 2933 (As Sent to Governor)

- AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 49-7-51, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROVIDE A PENALTY FOR THE SALE OF WILD ANIMALS, BIRDS OR FISH OVER A CERTAIN VALUE; TO PROVIDE THAT SECTION 49-7-51, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, APPLIES TO WILD ANIMALS, BIRDS AND FISH IN ADDITION TO GAME ANIMALS, BIRDS AND FISH; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 SECTION 1. Section 49-7-51, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 49-7-51. (1) It is unlawful for any person to buy or sell
- 10 or to offer for sale, exchange for merchandise, or other
- 11 consideration, within this state, any game birds, game animals, or
- 12 game fish, or parts thereof, named in this chapter, whether taken
- 13 within or coming from without the state, except as specifically
- 14 permitted by law or regulation. * * * The skins and sinew of deer
- 15 may be bought and sold at any time. A violation of this
- 16 <u>sub</u>section is a Class I violation and is punishable as provided in
- 17 Section 49-7-141.
- 18 (2) Any person who buys, sells, offers for sale, exchange
- 19 for merchandise, or other consideration, any wild bird, wild
- 20 <u>animal or fish that has been taken illegally is guilty of a Class</u>
- 21 <u>I violation and punished as provided in Section 49-7-141.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 23 and after July 1, 1999.
