1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE TRANSFER OF THE HISTORIC SHAIFER HOUSE AND ACCOMPANYING LAND LOCATED ON THE PORT GIBSON BATTLEFIELD FROM THE GRAND GULF MILITARY MONUMENT COMMISSION TO THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY; TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY TO PRESERVE AND DEVELOP THE HISTORIC SHAIFER HOUSE AND ACCOMPANYING LAND; TO AUTHORIZE THE DEPARTMENT OF ARCHIVES AND HISTORY TO ENTER INTO COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS WITH ENTITIES INTERESTED IN THE PRESERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE SHAIFER HOUSE AND ACCOMPANYING LAND; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES.		
11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:		
12	SECTION 1. The Department of Finance and Administration, on		
13	behalf of the State of Mississippi, may convey all right, title		
14	and interest in certain state-owned real property located in		
15	Claiborne County, Mississippi, to the State of Mississippi, for		
16	the use and benefit of the Mississippi Department of Archives and		
17	History, the property being known as the historic Shaifer House		
18	and accompanying land located on the Port Gibson Battlefield, and		
19	being more particularly described as follows:		
20	Tract No. 1: That certain tract of land known		
21	as the old Shaifer house tract; for survey,		
22	begin at point on the southerly side of the		
23	public road, where it is intersected by the		
24	line between Parcels 1 and 2 of the partition		
25	of the Shaifer Estate property as described in		
26	partition deed executed by us and now recorded		
27	Book 10-B, page 177 of the land records of		
28	said county, and which partition deed together		
29	with the plat recorded therewith is here		
30	referred to for full description of the		
31	location of said starting point, and run		
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thence in a northeasterly direction along said 33 old Port Gibson and Rodney public road, 1307 34 feet to point where said road is intersected on its North side by a fence, and which point 35 36 is point of beginning for survey of this tract 37 (and which point is further located as being 38 North 88° 45' East 1434.67 feet from the most 39 eastern corner of Section 16, Township 11 North, Range 2 East). From said point of 40 beginning run thence along fence, North 35° 41 West 134 feet; thence continue along fence, 42 South 35° West 15 feet, South 86° West 16 feet 43 to fence corner; thence along another fence, 44 45 North 40° West 191 feet to fence corner; thence along another fence, North 40° East 160 46 feet; thence continue along fence, North 64° 47 48 East 217 feet to point on private farm road; 49 thence along said road, South 31° 45' East 372 feet to point where the same forks; thence 50 51 along the fork going southwesterly 100 feet to 52 old Port Gibson and Rodney public/road; thence along said old Port Gibson and Rodney public 53 54 road, in a southwesterly direction, 225 feet to point of beginning. Said tract contains 55 3.0 acres, more or less, and lies in Section 56 Twelve (12), Township Eleven (11) North, Range 57 58 Two (2) East. Said land is the same as is fully described in Section V of said above 59 mentioned partition deed executed by the 60 grantors, now recorded Book 10-B, page 177 of 61 the deed records of said Claiborne County, 62 63 which is here referred to in aid of description and for all purposes. All of the 64 65 above is in accordance with survey made by R.D. Wade, Jr., and copy of plat of his survey 66 67 is attached hereto and made a part hereof by 68 reference.

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69		Tract No. 2: That certain tract of land being
70		the site of the old Magnolia Church; to arrive
71		at point of beginning for survey of this
72		tract, begin at the most eastern corner of
73		Section Sixteen (16), Township Eleven (11)
74		North, Range Two (2) East, and run thence
75		South 74° 34' East 2,917.7 feet to stake on
76		South side of public road, and run thence
77		South 84° 45' East 49 feet to fence corner
78		on South side of said road, which is point of
79		beginning for survey of this tract; and which
80		point is also the point where the East line of
81		Parcel 2 in the partition of the Shaifer
82		Estate property as described in partition deed
83		executed by us and now recorded Book 10-B,
84		page 177 of the land records of said Claiborne
85		County, intersects said public road, and which
86		partition deed, together with plat recorded
87		therewith, is here referred to in aid of
88		description of location of said starting
89		point. From said point of beginning, continue
90		thence along road, South 84° 45' East 282.04
91		feet to stake in fence and property line;
92		thence along fence and property line, South
93		46° West 396 feet to stake in fence corner;
94		thence along fence (which is the East line of
95		Parcel 2 of the partition above referred
96		to), North 17 East 109 feet, North 16°
97		East
98		69 feet, North 2°, West 52 feet and North 16°
99		West 78 feet to point of beginning. Said tract
100		contains 1.29 acres, more or less, and lies in
101		Section Twelve (12), Township Eleven (11) North,
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- 102 Range Two (2) East.
- The Secretary of State shall approve this conveyance and join
- 104 in this conveyance for all purposes.
- 105 SECTION 2. The Mississippi Department of Archives and
- 106 History is authorized to secure, preserve, restore, develop,
- 107 interpret, operate and maintain the historic Shaifer House and
- 108 accompanying land located on the Port Gibson Battlefield, subject
- 109 to the appropriation of adequate funds by the Legislature.
- 110 SECTION 3. The Board of Trustees of the Mississippi
- 111 Department of Archives and History is authorized to enter into
- 112 cooperative agreements with the National Park Service, state and
- 113 local governmental entities, nonprofit organizations, and any
- 114 other groups, organizations or individuals that may be interested
- in the preservation and development of the Shaifer House and
- 116 accompanying land and the Port Gibson Battlefield.
- 117 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 118 and after its passage.
