SENATE BILL NO. 2973 (As Passed the Senate)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 65-1-165, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 1 2 TO AUTHORIZE KEEP MISSISSIPPI BEAUTIFUL, INC., TO IMPLEMENT AN 3 ANNUAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' AWARDS PROGRAM FOR DISTINGUISHED SERVICE IN IMPLEMENTING THE LITTER LAWS; TO AUTHORIZE A 4 5 NON-MONETARY AWARD AND TO PROHIBIT THE PURCHASE OF THAT AWARD FROM б PUBLIC FUNDS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE 7 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 8 9 SECTION 1. Section 65-1-165, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows: 10 11 65-1-165. (1) The State Department of Transportation may 12 execute a contract with Keep Mississippi Beautiful, Inc., to develop and implement a comprehensive statewide program of litter 13 14 prevention. The contract shall contain provisions to require that Keep Mississippi Beautiful, Inc., will: 15 (a) Encourage and assist local communities to become 16 17 certified Keep America Beautiful systems: (b) Serve as a state clearinghouse of information on 18 19 ideas and projects to make local litter prevention programs more effective; 20 21 (C) Implement statewide communication programs to alert 2.2 people to the problem of littering and how it can be corrected; (d) Coordinate an annual statewide project which will 23 24 heighten public awareness of the problem of littering; 25 (e) Establish an annual awards program to recognize 26 individual and community achievement in litter prevention, 27 including law enforcement officers as provided in subsection (2) of this section; 28 29 (f) Serve as the authority which approves and disburses

No. 2973 99\SS02\R1151CS PAGE 1 financial assistance to any nonprofit corporation, county or municipality which, in a written application, seeks * * * assistance to implement a local litter prevention project. The financial assistance authorized herein shall not exceed forty percent (40%) of the cost of the local litter prevention project for which * * * assistance is sought.

36 (g) Encourage donation of funds from the private sector
37 to assist in defraying the operation of the litter prevention
38 program implemented <u>under</u> this section.

39 The contract may include any additional provisions which the 40 <u>State Department of Transportation</u> deems necessary to effectuate 41 the litter prevention program contemplated by this section.

42 Keep Mississippi Beautiful, Inc., shall submit to the <u>State</u> 43 <u>Department of Transportation</u> on or before August 1 of each year a 44 written report detailing the operation of the litter prevention 45 program statewide and its expenditure of monies for such program 46 during the preceding state fiscal year.

47 (2) Keep Mississippi Beautiful, Inc., may implement an
48 annual awards program to recognize law enforcement officers who
49 have distinguished themselves in the enforcement of litter laws.
50 Keep Mississippi Beautiful, Inc., may provide a non-monetary award
51 to each recognized law enforcement officer. The non-monetary
52 award shall not be paid for from public funds.
53 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from

54 and after July 1, 1999.
