## SENATE BILL NO. 2974

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 41-29-507, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO PROHIBIT AN INDIVIDUAL TO OWN, POSSESS, INSTALL, OPERATE OR MONITOR CERTAIN ELECTRONIC, MECHANICAL OR OTHER DEVICES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

- 7 SECTION 1. Section 41-29-507, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 8 amended as follows:
- 9 41-29-507. (1) No person nor any agency of the state or any
- 10 political subdivision thereof, other than the Bureau of Narcotics,
- 11 is authorized by this article to own, possess, install, operate or
- 12 monitor an electronic, mechanical or other device. The Bureau of
- 13 Narcotics may be assisted by an investigative or law enforcement
- 14 officer in the operation and monitoring of an interception of
- 15 wire, oral or other communications, provided that an agent of the
- 16 Bureau of Narcotics is present at all times.
- 17 (2) The director shall designate, in writing, the agents of
- 18 the Bureau of Narcotics who are responsible for the possession,
- 19 installation, operation and monitoring of electronic, mechanical
- 20 or other devices for the bureau.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 22 and after its passage.
