SENATE BILL NO. 2979

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 51-5-1, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 2 REQUIRE LICENSED WATER WELL CONTRACTORS TO MEET CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS PRESCRIBED BY THE COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY; TO CONFORM TERMS TO REORGANIZATION 4 5 NOMENCLATURE; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE б LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

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- 8 SECTION 1. Section 51-5-1, Mississippi Code of 1972, is
- 9 amended as follows:
- 51-5-1. (1) Every person, firm and corporation engaging in 10
- the business of drilling wells for underground water in the State 11
- of Mississippi shall file an application with the * * * commission 12
- for a drilling license, using forms prepared by the commission, 13
- 14 setting out qualifications therefor and such other information,
- 15 including any examination, oral or written, as may be required by
- the commission. The fee for the license and renewal * * * shall 16
- 17 be One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each year.
- (2) All licenses shall expire on June 30 of each year and 18
- 19 shall not be transferable and shall be renewable annually, without
- qualifying examination, upon payment of the required fee. 20
- 21 license shall not be renewed unless the person submits proof of
- completion of four (4) hours of continuing education as prescribed 22
- by the commission. 23
- (3) Nothing in this chapter shall prevent a person without a 24
- 25 license from constructing a water well on his own or leased
- property intended for use only in a single family house which is 26
- his permanent residence, or intended for use only for watering 27
- livestock on his farm, and * * * the waters * * * are not * * * 28

- 29 for use by the public or any residence other than his own.
- 30 However, the person shall comply with all rules and regulations
- 31 for the construction of wells <u>under</u> this chapter.
- 32 (4) This section shall not apply to any person who performs
- 33 labor or services at the direction and under the personal
- 34 supervision of a licensed well contractor.
- 35 (5) * * * The application for renewal * * * shall extend the
- 36 validity of the current license until the new license is received
- 37 or the applicant is notified * * * that $\underline{\text{the commission}}$ has refused
- 38 to renew the license. On application made after June 30 of each
- 39 year, the license <u>may</u> be renewed only upon payment of the
- 40 applicable fee, plus a penalty of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) for each
- 41 month or fraction thereof \underline{that} the application is delinquent. \underline{A}
- 42 delinquency in excess of one (1) year may, in the discretion of
- 43 the * * * commission, be deemed as a waiver of the driller's right
- 44 for renewal * * * . * * The commission may require that the
- 45 <u>person</u> be considered as a new applicant, including the requirement
- 46 for examination.
- 47 (6) <u>The commission may require</u> any person whose license has
- 48 been revoked * * * to take the examination and meet the
- 49 <u>requirements of</u> a new applicant.
- 50 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 51 and after July 1, 1999.
