7	SECTION 1. Section 87-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is

9	87-3-7. Special form not required; gifts given under a power
10	of attorney.
11	(1) A letter of attorney to transact any business need only
12	express plainly the authority conferred.
13	(2) If any power of attorney or other writing (a) authorizes
14	an attorney-in-fact or other agent to do, execute or perform any
15	act that the principal might or could do, or (b) evidences the
16	principal's intent to give the attorney-in-fact or agent full
17	power to handle the principal's affairs or deal with the
18	principal's property, the attorney-in-fact or agent shall have the
19	power and authority to make gifts in any amount of any of the
20	principal's property to any individuals or to any organizations
21	described in Sections 170(c) and 2522(a) of the Internal Revenue
22	Code or corresponding future provisions of federal tax law, or
23	both, in accordance with the principal's personal history of
24	making or joining in the making of lifetime gifts.
25	(3) Subsection (2) as set forth above is declaratory of past
26	and present law in the State of Mississippi, and shall be applied
