## SENATE BILL NO. 3004 (As Sent to Governor)

AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 87-3-7, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO 1 CLARIFY EVIDENCE OF A PRINCIPAL'S INTENT TO GIVE AN 2 ATTORNEY-IN-FACT OR AGENT FULL POWER TO GIVE GIFTS IN ACCORDANCE 3 WITH THE PRINCIPAL'S PERSONAL HISTORY OF MAKING OR JOINING IN THE 4 MAKING OF LIFETIME GIFTS; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 6 7 SECTION 1. Section 87-3-7, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 8 amended as follows: 9 87-3-7. Special form not required; gifts given under a power of attorney. 10 (1) A letter of attorney to transact any business need only 11 express plainly the authority conferred. 12 13 (2) If any power of attorney or other writing (a) authorizes 14 an attorney-in-fact or other agent to do, execute or perform any act that the principal might or could do, or (b) evidences the 15 16 principal's intent to give the attorney-in-fact or agent full power to handle the principal's affairs or deal with the 17 principal's property, the attorney-in-fact or agent shall have the 18 power and authority to make gifts in any amount of any of the 19 principal's property to any individuals or to any organizations 20 21 described in Sections 170(c) and 2522(a) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding future provisions of federal tax law, or 2.2 23 both, in accordance with the principal's personal history of making or joining in the making of lifetime gifts. 24 25 (3) Subsection (2) as set forth above is declaratory of past and present law in the State of Mississippi, and shall be applied 26 27 to all powers of attorney, whether executed before, on or after
