- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In all contracts or purchases for the provision
- of goods or services to a gaming licensee's licensed gaming
- 7 establishment and related facilities, the licensee shall give
- 8 preference and priority to Mississippi residents, laborers,
- 9 vendors and suppliers except where not reasonably possible to do
- 10 so without added expense, substantial inconvenience or sacrifice
- 11 in operational efficiency. In considering applicants for
- 12 employment, the licensee shall give preference and priority to
- 13 Mississippi residents; and, of persons who are hired after July 1,
- 14 1999, not less than eighty percent (80%) shall have been residents
- of this state for at least one (1) year immediately prior to
- 16 employment.
- 17 Each gaming licensee shall report annually to the commission,
- 18 at a time determined by the commission, regarding the licensee's
- 19 compliance with the provisions of this section.
- 20 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 21 and after July 1, 1999.
