SENATE BILL NO. 3020

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE MISSISSIPPI DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CONDUCT A STUDY TO DETERMINE THE FEASIBILITY OF CONSTRUCTING A 2 BRIDGE ACROSS THE BIG BLACK RIVER CONNECTING WARREN AND HINDS 4 COUNTIES; AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES. BE IT ENACTED BY THE 5 LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: б 7 SECTION 1. The Mississippi Department of Transportation 8 shall conduct a study to determine the feasibility of constructing 9 a bridge across the Big Black River connecting Warren and Hinds Counties, beginning at the Flowers exit on Interstate 20 and 10 11 extending southerly to U.S. Highway 80. Such study shall include 12 the estimated cost of construction, the projected vehicular traffic count across such bridge, the date that preliminary 13 14 engineering and right-of-way acquisition may begin, the approximate date of the letting of all contracts for such 15 16 construction, the approximate date of final completion of construction, a comparative analysis of other locations in the 17 18 general vicinity suitable for the construction of a similar bridge, and such other information and data as the department 19 deems helpful for determining the feasibility of such project. A 20 21 copy of the study shall be filed no later than January 1, 2000, 22 with the Clerk of the House of Representatives and the Secretary 2.3 of the Senate. SECTION 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from 2.4 and after July 1, 1999. 25
