SENATE BILL NO. 3051

1 AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 97-15-21, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, 2 TO REVISE THE PENALTY FOR INTERFERING WITH A LEVEE CATTLE GAP; TO 3 AMEND SECTION 97-15-23, MISSISSIPPI CODE OF 1972, TO REVISE THE 4 OFFENSE OF AND PENALTY FOR DISFIGURING A LEVEE; TO REVISE THE 5 PENALTY FOR DISCHARGING A WEAPON ON A LEVEE; AND FOR RELATED 6 PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. Section 97-15-21, Mississippi Code of 1972, is amended as follows:

97-15-21. If any person shall willfully cut, break down, 10 11 remove, destroy or damage any cattle gap or any fence or part thereof erected by any board of levee commissioners or the agents 12 or employees of said board of levee commissioners for the purpose 13 14 of enclosing the public levee right-of-way under the control of said board of levee commissioners or who shall break down, remove 15 or destroy any gate in any such fence, or shall willfully leave 16 unclosed and open any such gate after having opened same, or make 17 18 said levee or said levee right-of-way a place of deposit or storage for any woodpiles or refuse, garbage or dead animals or 19 any cotton, lumber, bricks or any other commodities, or who shall 20 21 willfully do any material damage injurious to said levee, such person or persons shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, on 22 conviction, shall be fined not less than One Hundred Dollars 23 (\$100.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each 24 25 offense. In addition to the penalties herein provided for, if any 26 levee board is required to remove any such forbidden objects 27 herein described, the owner or owners of such forbidden objects shall be liable in damages to the levee board for the cost of 28

No. 3051 99\SS26\R996 PAGE 1 29 removing such objects, which damages may be recovered in a court 30 action brought for that purpose; and the said levee board shall 31 have a right of action against any person for any other damage 32 sustained to the levees by reason of a violation of this section. 33 SECTION 2. Section 97-15-23, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 34 amended as follows:

97-15-23. If any person or persons shall wilfully cut into, 35 36 mutilate or disfigure any public levee, or excavate dirt or sand from the right-of-way owned by any board of levee commissioners or 37 any part thereof, or trespass upon said levee in violation of 38 posted regulation without being authorized to do so by the said 39 board of levee commissioners, such person or persons shall be 40 41 guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction shall be fined not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than One Thousand 42 Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each offense, or shall be confined in the 43 44 county jail for a term not exceeding thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court. 45

46 SECTION 3. Section 97-15-27, Mississippi Code of 1972, is 47 amended as follows:

48 97-15-27. If any person shall hunt or engage in target practice upon the mainline levee structure erected by any board of 49 50 levee commissioners, the entire landside right-of-way of said levee structure or the riverside right-of-way of said levee 51 structure within a distance of two hundred (200) feet from the toe 52 53 of said levee structure, such person or persons shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, on conviction, shall be fined not less than One 54 55 Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense. 56

57 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from 58 and after July 1, 1999.
