In addition to all other sums heretofore 9 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 10 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 11 defraying the expenses of the Office of the Attorney General for 12 the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999..... \$21,658.00. 13 14 This additional appropriation is made for the purpose of 15 defraying the costs of expert witness fees incurred by the Office of the Attorney General. 16 SECTION 2. In addition to all other sums heretofore 17 appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be 18 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 19 20 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of paying a settlement against the State of Mississippi for the fiscal year 21 22 ending June 30, 1999.....\$ 2,500.00. 23 This additional appropriation is made for the purpose of paying a settlement in Civil Action No. 1:95 CV91-S-D, Hall v. 24 25 Gadd in the United States District Court for the Northern District of Mississippi; Eastern Division. 26 27 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds 28

- 29 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
- 30 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
- 31 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
- 32 in the manner provided by law.
