## SENATE BILL NO. 3086 (As Passed the Senate)

1 2 3	AN ACT MAKING AN ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE MISSISSIPPI VETERANS MEMORIAL STADIUM COMMISSION FOR FISCAL YEAR 1999.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
5	SECTION 1. In addition to all other sums heretofore
6	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
7	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
8	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
9	defraying the expenses of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial
10	Stadium Commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1999
11	\$ 75,000.00.
12	SECTION 2. In addition to all other sums heretofore
13	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
14	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
15	Treasury to the credit of the Mississippi Veterans Memorial
16	Stadium Fund, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the
17	Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission for the fiscal
18	year ending June 30, 1999\$ 125,000.00.
19	SECTION 3. With the funds appropriated under the provisions
20	of Sections 1 and 2, the following positions are authorized:
21	AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:
22	Permanent: Full Time 2
23	SECTION 4. This additional appropriation is made for the
24	purpose of providing funds and spending authority needed by the
25	Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission to provide the
26	services in its new contract with the Mississippi Pride, a

- 27 representative of the Regional Football League. It is the
- 28 intention of the Legislature that the commission be authorized to
- 29 purchase a new sport utility vehicle with the funds appropriated
- 30 under the provisions of this act.
- 31 SECTION 5. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
- 32 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
- 33 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
- 34 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
- 35 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
- 36 in the manner provided by law.
- 37 SECTION 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 38 and after its passage.
