BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: SECTION 1. In addition to all other sums heretofore
7	appropriated, the following sum, or so much thereof as may be
8	necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
9	General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of
LO	defraying the expenses of the Veterans Affairs Board for the
L1	period beginning upon passage and through June 30, 2000
L2	\$ 3,100,000.00.
L3	SECTION 2. This additional appropriation is made for the
L4	purpose of providing the funds necessary to increase the direct
L5	care nursing staff that is needed to properly care for the men and
L6	women who reside in the four (4) State Veterans Homes.
L7	SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
L8	the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
L9	as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
20	Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
21	upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers
22	in the manner provided by law.
