The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 10 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of 11 Finance and Administration, for the purpose of defraying the 12 expenses of the inaugural ceremonies and other necessary expenses 13 14 of the incoming Governor, for the fiscal year beginning 15 July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... \$ 60,000.00.

SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 16 17 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of 18 Finance and Administration, for the purpose of defraying the 19 20 expenses of the former Governor which are necessary to conclude his public obligations and responsibilities, as provided by 21 22 Section 7-1-151, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 23 24\$ 30,000.00. SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 25 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds 26
