SENATE BILL NO. 3130
(As Passed the Senate)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION OF STATE GENERAL FUNDS TO THE
2 DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF
3 DEFRAYING THE EXPENSES OF THE INAUGURAL CEREMONIES AND OTHER
4 NECESSARY EXPENSES OF THE INCOMING GOVERNOR; AND TO DEFRAY THE
5 EXPENSES OF THE FORMER GOVERNOR WHICH ARE NECESSARY TO CONCLUDE
6 HIS PUBLIC OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES IN AN ORDERLY MANNER,
7 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:

9 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
10 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
11 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of
12 Finance and Administration, for the purpose of defraying the
13 expenses of the inaugural ceremonies and other necessary expenses
14 of the incoming Governor, for the fiscal year beginning
15 July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... \$ 60,000.00.

16 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be
17 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State
18 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, to the Department of
19 Finance and Administration, for the purpose of defraying the
20 expenses of the former Governor which are necessary to conclude
21 his public obligations and responsibilities, as provided by
22 Section 7-1-151, Mississippi Code of 1972, for the fiscal year
23 beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....
24 \$ 30,000.00.

25 SECTION 3. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by
26 the State Treasurer out of any money in the proper fund or funds
27 as set forth in this act, upon warrants issued by the State Fiscal
28 Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants
29 upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers

30 in the manner provided by law.

31 SECTION 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from
32 and after July 1, 1999.
