SENATE BILL NO. 3134 (As Sent to Governor)

1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES OF THE STATE BOARD FOR COMMUNITY AND 3 JUNIOR COLLEGES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2000.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be б necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of 8 defraying the administrative expenses of the State Board for 9 Community and Junior Colleges for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000.....\$ 8,177,229.00. 10 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 11 12 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 13 Treasury to the credit of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges, for the purpose of defraying the administrative expenses 14 of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges for the 15 fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 16 \$ 18,575,690.00. 17 SECTION 3. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 18 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 19 20 Treasury to the credit of the Commission on Proprietary School and College Registration, for the purpose of defraying the expenses 21 incurred in the regulation and administration of the Mississippi 22 Proprietary School and College Registration Law and the associated 23 expenses of the State Board of Community and Junior Colleges for 24 the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000 25 26\$ 60,000.00.

SECTION 4. With the funds appropriated under the provisions of Sections 1, 2 and 3 the following positions are authorized: AUTHORIZED POSITIONS:

Any transfers or escalations shall be made in accordance with the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law.

No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this act and which are withdrawn and no longer available.

SECTION 5. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 40 budget requests of the administrative expenses of the State Board 41 42 for Community and Junior Colleges for Fiscal Year 2001 shall be 43 submitted to the Joint Legislative Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the format and level of detail 44 provided during the Fiscal Year 2000 budget request process. 45 SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Eight 46 47 Million Five Hundred Sixty Thousand Nine Hundred Two Dollars (\$8,560,902.00) shall be derived from Education Enhancement Funds 48

49 deposited pursuant to Section 27-103-203 (1), Mississippi Code of 50 1972.

51 SECTION 7. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, Two 52 Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,600,000.00) shall be 53 expended from the Work Force Carryover Fund as created by House 54 Bill No. 1271, Regular Session of 1995.

55 SECTION 8. With the funds provided herein, it is the 56 intention of the Legislature that the State Board of Community and 57 Junior Colleges shall allocate an additional One Hundred Thousand 58 Dollars (\$100,000.00) above any Workforce Project funds 59 distributed to the Coahoma Community College Skill/Tech Center for

60 the Fiscal Year 1999.

61 SECTION 9. Of the funds appropriated in Sections 1 and 2, 62 funds in the amount of Seventeen Million Eight Hundred Seventeen Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-three Dollars (\$17,817,573.00) are 63 64 appropriated for the Workforce Education Program and Industrial 65 Training. No funding obligation or commitment shall be made on behalf of the state for industrial training beyond the level of 66 funding made available in this section. All industrial training 67 68 program commitments made in Fiscal Year 2000 and future fiscal 69 years shall be based only upon funds available in this section and 70 any proposed commitments shall be approved by the Executive 71 Director of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges, or 72 the Executive Director's designee prior to such commitment being 73 finalized. Industrial training program commitments shall be made 74 and based only upon training services provided and not for a 75 specific funding amount. Any expenditures of funds authorized in 76 this section are limited to obligations made July 1, 1999, or 77 after, and shall not be expended for obligations made prior to 78 this date.

SECTION 10. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, funds in the amount of One Hundred Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$125,000.00) shall be derived from Community College Network fees for the purpose of defraying the costs of the Community College Network and the administrative expenses of the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges.

SECTION 11. Of the funds appropriated in Section 2, an amount up to Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be allocated for up to four (4) community and junior colleges to participate in the Industrial Training Program which will lead to a four-year degree at the University of Southern Mississippi. SECTION 12. Of the funds appropriated under the provisions

91 of this act, it is the intention of the Legislature that an amount 92 not to exceed One Hundred Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$117,000.00)

93 shall be used to defray the costs of a technology training program94 for the Community and Junior Colleges and Public Education.

95 SECTION 13. Of the funds provided herein, Two Hundred 96 Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) is provided to the State Board for 97 Community and Junior Colleges for transfer to the Mississippi 98 Authority for Educational Television for a mobile digital 99 production van.

SECTION 14. Of the funds provided herein, Nine Million One Hundred Nine Thousand, One Hundred Twenty-one Dollars (\$9,109,121.00) are provided to accomplish the transfer of the Industrial Training and Post-secondary Adult Education programs from the State Department of Education to the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges. It is intended that these funds be allocated to the Workforce Education Program.

In the event that Senate Bill No. 2796, 1999 Regular Session, is not enacted into law, then this appropriation shall be reduced by Six Million Eight Hundred Nine Thousand One Hundred Twenty-one Dollars (\$6,809,121.00) in general funds and Two Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,300,000.00) in special funds and seven (7) permanent, full-time positions.

113 SECTION 15. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the 114 115 credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 116 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the 117 118 proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 119 SECTION 16. Should revenues generated and deposited to the 120 Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Section 27-103-203 (1), 121 Mississippi Code of 1972, and apportioned pursuant to Section 37-61-33 (6), Mississippi Code of 1972, fall below funds 122 123 appropriated herein from said source, the State Board for 124 Community and Junior Colleges shall notify the Department of 125 Finance and Administration as to which allotments shall be reduced

126 to insure that expenditures do not exceed actual revenues.

127 SECTION 17. This act shall take effect and be in force from 128 and after July 1, 1999.

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
