1 AN ACT MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEFRAYING 2 THE EXPENSES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI MEDICAL CENTER FOR 3 FISCAL YEAR 2000.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI: 5 SECTION 1. The following sum, or so much thereof as may be 6 necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the State 7 General Fund not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of defraying the expenses of The University of Mississippi Medical 8 9 Center for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1999, and ending 10 June 30, 2000.....\$ 151,170,980.00. SECTION 2. The following sum of money, or so much thereof as 11 12 may be necessary, is hereby authorized and approved for 13 expenditure out of the proceeds derived from patient fees, student fees or any other special source funds which are collected by or 14 otherwise become available, for the support and maintenance of The 15 University of Mississippi Medical Center for the fiscal year 16 beginning July 1, 1999, and ending June 30, 2000..... 17 371,030,783.00. 18 SECTION 3. Any escalations shall be made in accordance with 19 20 the terms, conditions, and procedures established by law. No general funds authorized to be expended herein shall be 21 used to replace federal funds and/or other special funds which are 22 being used for salaries authorized under the provisions of this 23 24 act and which are withdrawn and no longer available. SECTION 4. With the funds appropriated and authorized for 25 expenditure under the provisions of Section 1 and Section 2, the 26 27 University of Mississippi Medical Center shall maintain the School

S. B. No. 3138 99\SS26\A280SG PAGE 1 of Medicine, the School of Dentistry, the School of Nursing, the School of Health Related Professions, the Teaching Hospital and the Medical Center Service Area. The University of Mississippi Medical Center shall prepare and make available to the Legislature an accounting of expenditures for each of the divisions listed in this section at the beginning of the legislative session.

34 SECTION 5. Due to critical nurse shortages and staffing, it 35 is the intent of the Legislature to enhance recognition of 36 excellence and expand the experience factor in attracting 37 qualified registered nurses.

SECTION 6. Of the funds appropriated in Section 1, and the 38 funds authorized to be expended in Section 2, none may be used to 39 40 provide medical services on behalf of any state agency, institution or political subdivision, except to the extent that 41 such agency, institution or political subdivision reimburses the 42 hospital for the cost of the services provided. Upon the 43 44 rendering of medical services to any such agency, institution or political subdivision, the hospital shall issue an invoice for the 45 charges which shall be paid within ninety (90) days. 46 In the event 47 that payment is not made within ninety (90) days, the hospital shall discontinue providing services to that agency, institution, 48 49 or political subdivision until all outstanding charges have been 50 paid.

51 SECTION 7. Any funds appropriated pursuant to this act and 52 paid as a fee to or deposited in a financial institution shall be 53 in compliance with Section 109 of the Constitution of the State of 54 Mississippi and Section 25-4-103, Mississippi Code of 1972.

55 SECTION 8. It is the intention of the Legislature that the 56 University of Mississippi Medical Center's budget request for 57 Fiscal Year 2001 shall be submitted to the Joint Legislative 58 Budget Committee in a format and level of detail comparable to the 59 format and level of detail provided during the Fiscal Year 2000 60 budget request process.

61 SECTION 9. Of the funds authorized for expenditure in 62 Section 2, the following amounts shall be derived from the 63 Education Enhancement Fund as follows:

64 (a) Five Million Six Hundred Forty-four Thousand Two
 65 Hundred Thirty-three Dollars (\$5,644,233.00) shall be derived from
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funds deposited pursuant to Sections 27-65-75 and 27-67-31,
Mississippi Code of 1972.

68 One Million Three Hundred Sixty-three Thousand (b) Dollars (\$1,363,000.00) shall be derived from funds deposited 69 70 pursuant to Section 27-103-203 (1), Mississippi Code of 1972. SECTION 10. Should revenues generated and deposited to the 71 72 Education Enhancement Fund pursuant to Section 27-103-203(1), Mississippi Code of 1972, fall below funds appropriated herein 73 from said source, the Board of Trustees of State Institutions of 74 75 Higher Learning shall notify the Department of Finance and Administration as to which allotments shall be reduced to insure 76 77 that expenditures do not exceed actual revenues.

SECTION 11. The money herein appropriated shall be paid by 78 79 the State Treasurer out of any money in the State Treasury to the credit of the proper fund or funds as set forth in this act, upon 80 81 warrants issued by the State Fiscal Officer; and the State Fiscal 82 Officer shall issue his warrants upon requisitions signed by the proper person, officer or officers in the manner provided by law. 83 84 SECTION 12. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1, 1999. 85
